NURTURING YOUNG MINDS LEARNING PROGRAMME AT A GLANCE

The early years of childhood form the most crucial and formative phase in a child's life. It is during this sensitive period that the foundations of character, values, and attitudes are gently nurtured. At S D Heritage Pride School, Gurugram, we believe that these years provide a precious opportunity to instill age-old, time-honored values deeply rooted in our rich cultural heritage.

The primary objective of education at the Elementary Education Level is to foster the development of essential life skills. Emphasis is laid on building strong foundations in communication and numeracy, promoting healthy living habits, and introducing children to the basic concepts of their physical and social environment. Equal importance is given to nurturing creativity, curiosity, cooperation, and respect for others—skills that prepare children for the world of play, work, and culture.

Our thoughtfully designed students friendly programme aims at the holistic development of each child—physically, socially, emotionally, morally, and intellectually—so that every learner grows into a confident, compassionate, and well-rounded individual. It is inclined to assess them based on their skills rather than just theoretical knowledge.

Recognizing that young children learn best through direct, concrete, and meaningful experiences, our teaching-learning process is largely activity-based. Children are actively engaged in individual and group play, experiential tasks, theme-based learning, and hands-on activities that draw upon familiar situations and resources from their immediate surroundings.

The Annual Programme has been carefully curated in alignment with the vision and principles of NEP 2020, ensuring joyful learning, flexibility, and skill-based education. A range of thoughtfully planned activities supports the achievement of learning outcomes for foundational classes.

I. LANGUAGE SKILLS- English & Hindi Language Development

The language curriculum focuses on helping children communicate effectively.

Listening Skills: STORY , rhymes, riddles, sound games, and following instructions to improve attention and understanding.

Speaking Skills: Picture talk, discussions, show & tell, role play, dramatization, and rhymes to build confidence and clarity.

Reading Skills: Picture reading, phonics, word building, sight words, STORY cards, and library reading to improve fluency.

Writing: Matching, sentence formation, picture composition, creative writing, dictation, and punctuation usage.

II. COGNITIVE SKILLS

Cognitive development at the pre-primary level focuses on building early thinking skills through play-based and hands-on activities.

Numeracy: Counting objects, number recognition, number tracing, Pre-number concepts.

Early Math Concepts: Understanding shapes, sorting and matching, patterns, comparison.

Environmental Awareness (EVS)/GK: Knowing body parts and hygiene, family members, classroom and neighbourhood helpers, animals and birds, plants, weather, transport, and cleanliness habits.

III. CREATIVE & EXPRESSIVE ARTS

Drawing, colouring, music, dance, and drama promote imagination, creativity, coordination and confidence.

IV. PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Activities strengthen motor skills and promote fitness, hygiene, health awareness, and an active lifestyle.

V. SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL GROWTH

Children learn cooperation, respect, empathy, confidence, and understanding of family, culture, and community.

EVALUATION SYSTEM

From the Academic Session 2026–27 onwards, there will be no formal written assessments or examinations for **Classes Nursery to UKG**. Keeping in view the developmental needs of young learners, the school follows a continuous, child-centric, and stress-free evaluation system that focuses on skill development, conceptual understanding, and overall holistic growth, rather than rote learning or marks-oriented performance.

To ensure continuity of learning, regular recapitulation and reinforcement assignments will be conducted as part of classroom practices. Students will be assessed through observation-based and activity-based methods, and only grades will be awarded to reflect progress. Marks will not be mentioned, thereby reducing academic pressure and encouraging joyful learning and all round development of the child.
