PARENTAL TIPS

5. **Kindness Through Role Play:** Use stuffed animals or figurines to simulate care giving activities like feeding, bathing, or comforting. This helps children understand empathy and kindness.

6. **Peacefulness and Mindfulness:** Introduce relaxation techniques by playing soft music and engaging in simple stretching exercises with deep breathing. Explain how calming the body and mind contributes to inner peace.
7. **Courtesy and Politeness:** Reinforce good manners by offering your child small treats one at a time, prompting them to say “please” before receiving and “thank you” after. Gradually introduce “you’re welcome” to complete the cycle of courtesy.
8. **Gentleness:** Provide delicate objects, such as framed photos or soft fabrics, and guide your child on handling them with care. Relate this to the need for gentleness when interacting with babies, pets, or fragile items.
9. **Generosity:** Encourage sharing by baking or preparing a special treat and delivering half to a neighbor. Allow the child to participate at their own comfort level, gradually building their confidence in giving.
10. **Courage and Confidence:** Support your child in facing new experiences, such as climbing a small ladder or interacting with a friendly pet. Offering reassurance and encouragement helps them embrace challenges with confidence.
