In this regard besides various modes of continuous evaluation and Terminal Assessments are conducted as per the given probable schedule for students.



#### PARENTAL TIPS

- 8. **Gentleness:** Provide delicate objects, such as framed photos or soft fabrics, and guide your child on handling them with care. Relate this to the need for gentleness when interacting with babies, pets, or fragile items.
- 9. **Generosity:** Encourage sharing by baking or preparing a special treat and delivering half to a neighbour. Allow the child to participate at their own comfort level, gradually building their confidence in giving.
- 10. Courage and Confidence: Support your child in facing new experiences, such as climbing a small ladder or interacting with a friendly pet. Offering reassurance and encouragement helps them embrace challenges with confidence.
