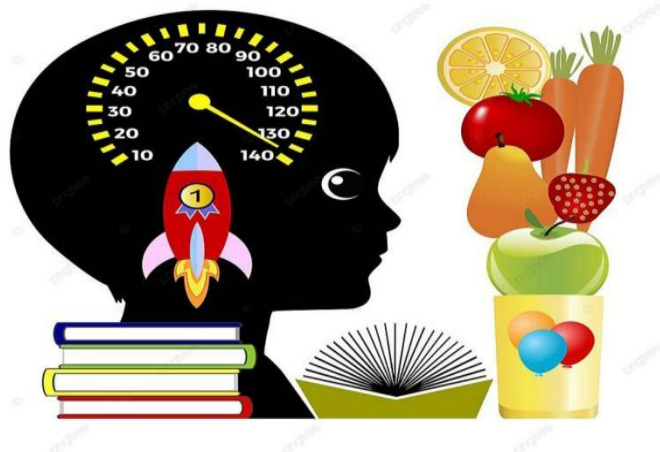
In this regard besides various modes of continuous evaluation and Terminal Assessments are conducted as per the given probable schedule for students.

PARENTAL TIPS

Children are naturally observant and quick to imitate the behaviors they see around them—both positive and negative. While healthy habits can be acquired through mere imitation, fostering values such as kindness, responsibility, and respect requires a more intentional approach.

One of the most effective ways to nurture character development in young children is through interactive activities that seamlessly integrate these values into their daily routines. By associating virtues (such as “kindness” or “responsibility”) with specific behaviors, children are encouraged to internalize these qualities through action.

The following activities are designed for children and can be incorporated effortlessly into play. These moments, though brief, contribute significantly to character building over time.

Here are 10 easy character-building activities for children:

1. **Service:** Encourage the habit of serving others by involving your child in simple acts of kindness, such as offering water to family members during mealtime.
2. **Gratitude:** Play the “Thank You Game” by taking turns giving small items (e.g., toys or snacks) while expressing gratitude with each exchange. This reinforces appreciation and politeness.
3. **Responsibility:** Assign age-appropriate tasks, such as putting away dishes or transferring laundry to the washing machine. While assistance may be needed initially, completing tasks fosters independence and self-confidence.
4. **Respect for Nature:** Teach respect by observing insects and birds together, emphasizing the importance of not disturbing their habitats.
5. **Kindness Through Role Play:** Use stuffed animals or figurines to simulate care giving activities like feeding, bathing, or comforting. This helps children understand empathy and kindness.



6. **Peacefulness and Mindfulness:** Introduce relaxation techniques by playing soft music and engaging in simple stretching exercises with deep breathing. Explain how calming the body and mind contributes to inner peace.
7. **Courtesy and Politeness:** Reinforce good manners by offering your child small treats one at a time, prompting them to say “please” before receiving and “thank you” after. Gradually introduce “you’re welcome” to complete the cycle of courtesy.
8. **Gentleness:** Provide delicate objects, such as framed photos or soft fabrics, and guide your child on handling them with care. Relate this to the need for gentleness when interacting with babies, pets, or fragile items.
9. **Generosity:** Encourage sharing by baking or preparing a special treat and delivering half to a neighbour. Allow the child to participate at their own comfort level, gradually building their confidence in giving.
10. **Courage and Confidence:** Support your child in facing new experiences, such as climbing a small ladder or interacting with a friendly pet. Offering reassurance and encouragement helps them embrace challenges with confidence.

By incorporating these simple yet impactful activities into everyday interactions, parents can play a crucial role in shaping their child’s character. Each small effort contributes to building a foundation of integrity, kindness, and resilience that will benefit children throughout their lives.
